MATERIAL LIST

HOOK: TMC 5262 or Daiichi 1710, #12 (or equivalent 2XL nymph hook)

WEIGHT: (optional): Lead Wire .015"

THREAD: Veevus 12/0 or UTC 70 denier or UNI 8/0, color Tan

RIB: Copper Wire, size BR

TAIL: **##** Lemon Barred Wood Duck barbs

ABDOMEN: **##** Natural Fur Australian Possum

COLLAR: **##** Lemon Barred Wood Duck barbs

THORAX: Natural Fur Australian Possum - (in a split thread dubbing loop)

Other items needed:

- These items will be available for in-person tiers if needed. If you know you're going to need material please arrive early enough to get everything before our scheduled start time.
